Morning, night and noon.

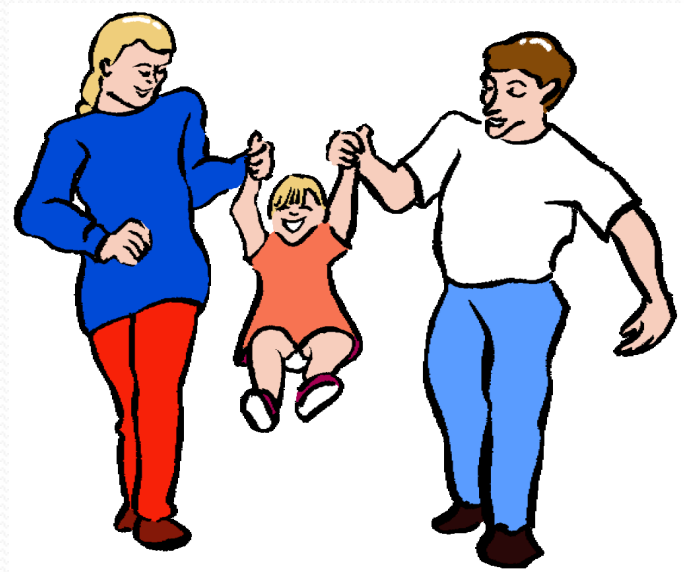


Write down the responsibilities for girls and for boys.
