Heraldic symbols of many Russian cities and regions talk about the geographical and economic situation, and the progress or natural resources.

Murmansk



Blue and yellow symbolize day and night.

Ship and fish are symbols of the main industry

Vladivostok



Amur tigers live here. That is why we can see here a tiger.

The tower is a symbol of the fortress and the anchor is a symbol of the port city

Ekaterinburg



Two colors indicate the border
between Europe and Asia.
Bear is a symbol of Russia, Sable
is a symbol of Asia

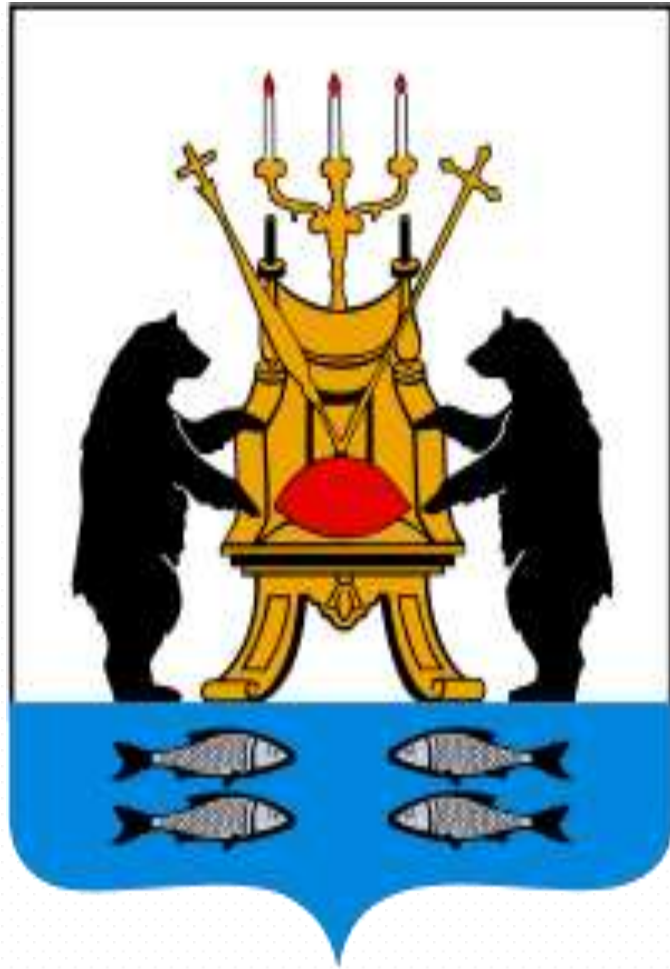
Tomsk

Three leopards in Pskov emblem symbolize the riches of the city

Vladimir

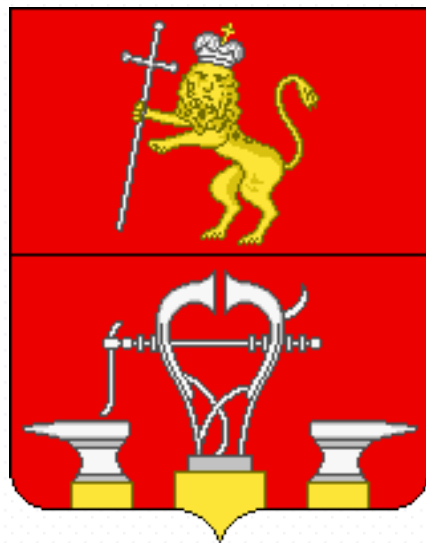


Lion's leopard in the crown represents independence

In the bottom are symbols of the city production

Vyazniki



At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom is the elm on the golden field, meaning the name of this city

Gorokhovets



At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom is Pea. It is a symbol of agriculture

Kirzhach



At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom is Owl.
It is a traditional symbol of wisdom.

Green is a symbol of nature

Kovrov



At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom are two hares that live here

Melenki



At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom is the mill.
It gave the name to the city

Murom

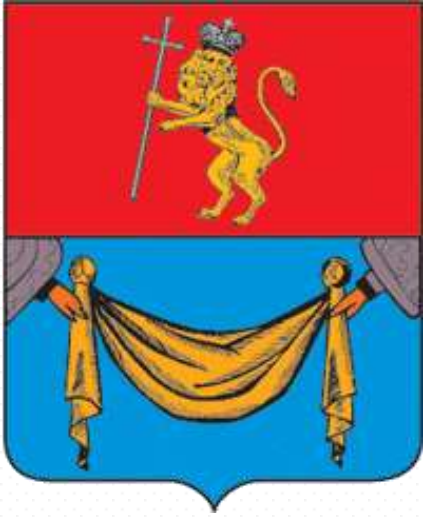


At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom there are three Kalachs

One legend tells that Catherine the Great loved to eat such bread here during her visit of this town.

Pokrov



At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom we can see two hands holding a golden veil

Sudogda



At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom there are four rakes symbolizing a city of agricultural orientation

Yuriev-Polsky



At the top is the symbol of Vladimir.

In the bottom there are two baskets of cherries, which grow here

Suzdal



It is a single emblem without a lion

On the emblem we see a falcon with an imperial crown

A falcon is a symbol of freedom and independence

This is due to the fact that once the city was the center of the Vladimir - Suzdal principality
