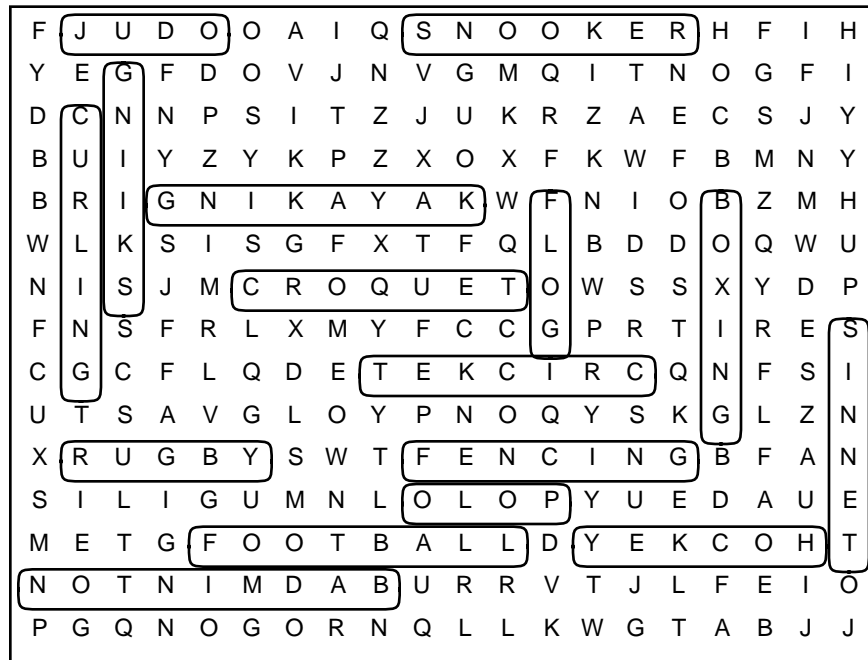

1. A racquet sport played by either two players (singles) or two pairs (doubles). Played on a court divided by a net with racquets and a tennis ball. [TENNIS]
2. A team sport, played outdoors, on a rugby pitch, with an oval rugby ball, and two teams of 15 players. [RUGBY]
3. Two or four people hit a shuttlecock over a high net. [BADMINTON]
4. it is a competitive winter sport in which the participant uses skis to glide on snow [SKIING]
5. it is a sport in which players slide stones on a sheet of ice towards a target area which is segmented into four concentric circles. It is related to bowls, boules and shuffleboard. [CURLING]
6. it is a contact team sport played on ice, usually in a rink, in which two teams of skaters use their sticks to shoot a vulcanized rubber puck into their opponent's net to score points. [HOCKEY]
7. A teamgame, usually played outdoors, on a cricket pitch, with a bat, a cricket ball, and stumps, There are 11 players on each team. You play a cricket match. [CRICKET]
8. A team sport, usually played outdoors, on a football pitch, with a round football, a goal, with two teams of 11 players, and a goal keeper (goalie). Americans insist on calling it soccer. [FOOTBALL]
9. Usually played by individuals, it is played on a golf course, using several types of golf clubs and a golf ball. [GOLF]
10. Two, three or four people use mallets to hit wooden balls through small metal hoops. [CROQUET]
11. Two people try to hit 15 red balls and 6 balls of different colours into six holes around a cloth-covered table. [SNOOKER]
12. Two teams ride horses and carry long wooden hammers with which they hit a small hard ball [POLO]
13. The sport of fighting with long thin swords [FENCING]
14. it is the use of a kayak for moving across water [KAYAKING]
15. it is a combat sport in which two people, usually wearing protective gloves, throw punches at each other for a predetermined amount of time in a boxing ring [BOXING]
16. it is a traditional Japanese wrestling sport developed in the 1880s. [JUDO]
