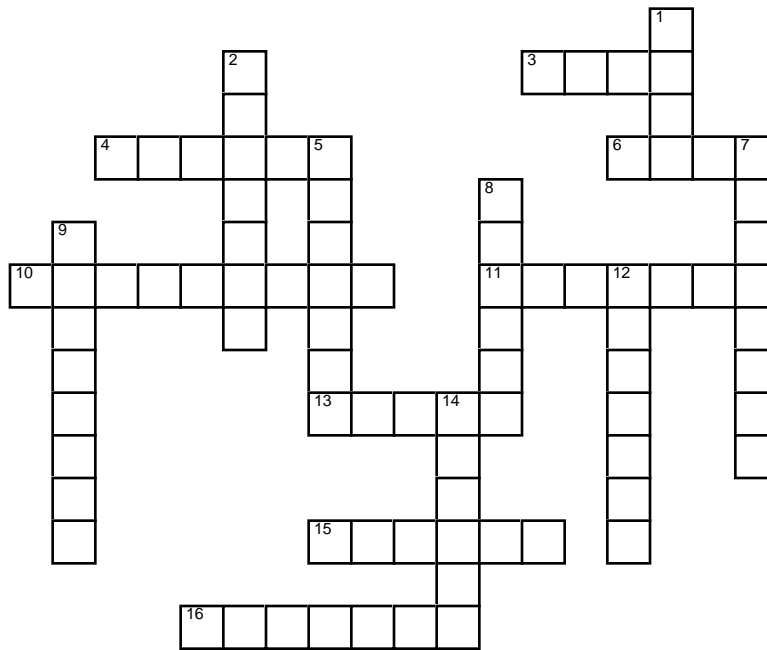

3. it is a traditional Japanese wrestling sport developed in the 1880s.
4. A racquet sport played by either two players (singles) or two pairs (doubles). Played on a court divided by a net with racquets and a tennis ball.
6. Usually played by individuals, it is played on a golf course, using several types of golf clubs and a golf ball.
10. Two or four people hit a shuttlecock over a high net.
11. A teamgame, usually played outdoors, on a cricket pitch, with a bat, a cricket ball, and stumps, There are 11 players on each team. You play a cricket match.
13. A team sport, played outdoors, on a rugby pitch, with an oval rugby ball, and two teams of 15 players.
15. it is a competitive winter sport in which the participant uses skis to glide on snow
16. it is a sport in which players slide stones on a sheet of ice towards a target area which is segmented into four concentric circles. It is related to bowls, boules and shuffleboard.

1. Two teams ride horses and carry long wooden hammers with which they hit a small hard ball
2. The sport of fighting with long thin swords
5. Two people try to hit 15 red balls and 6 balls of different colours into six holes around a cloth-covered table.
7. A team sport, usually played outdoors, on a football pitch, with a round football, a goal, with two teams of 11 players, and a goal keeper (goalie). Americans insist on calling it soccer.
8. it is a contact team sport played on ice, usually in a rink, in which two teams of skaters use their sticks to shoot a vulcanized rubber puck into their opponent's net to score points.
9. it is the use of a kayak for moving across water
12. Two, three or four people use mallets to hit wooden balls through small metal hoops.
14. it is a combat sport in which two people, usually wearing protective gloves, throw punches at each other for a predetermined amount of time in a boxing ring
