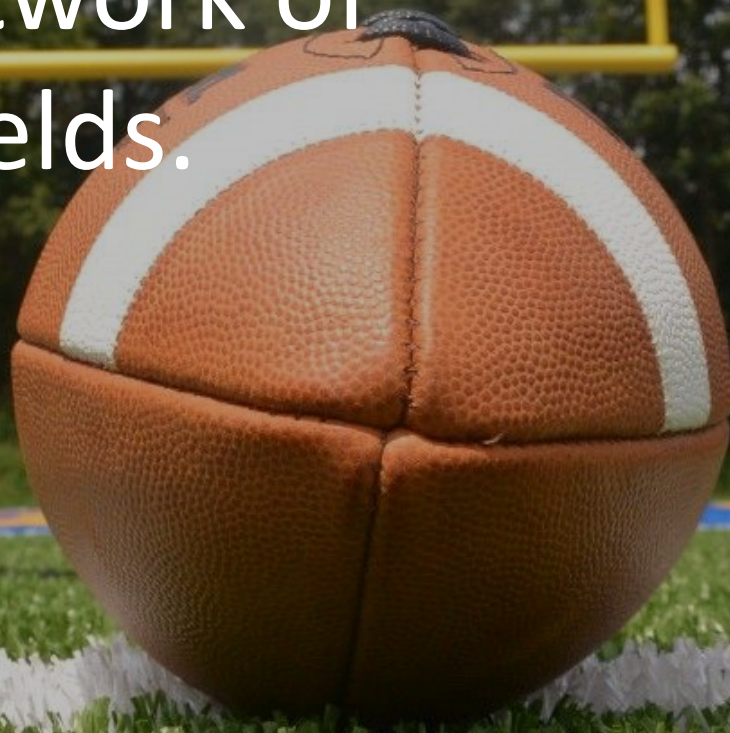


## In fact
