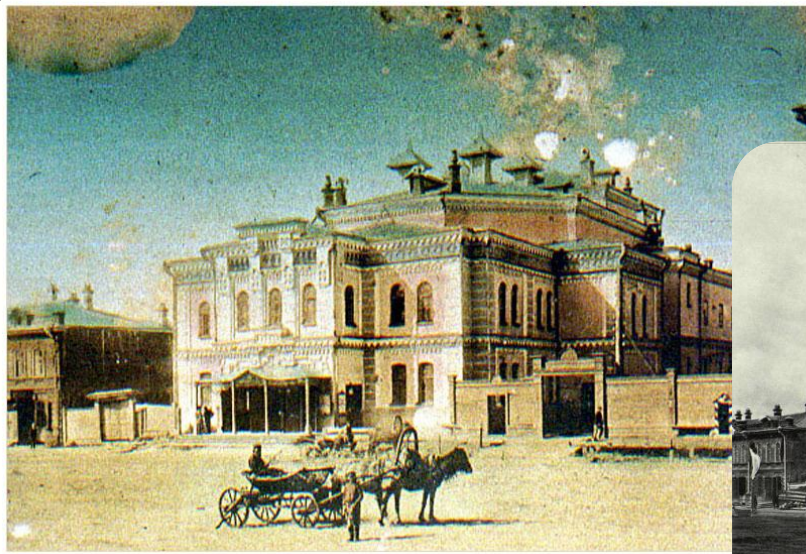

First theatre of Tomsk.

Tomsk theatre dates back to 1850, when Nikolai Evtikhievich Filimonov, a gold miner and city head, partly at his own expense, partly on the money collected by subscription, built the first wooden theater building in Tomsk. The first theatre in Tomsk existed for 32 years.

- **Korolevs Theatre**
- The first stone building of the theater in Tomsk was built by merchant Yevgraf Korolev in 1885 at his own expense. The project of the theater building, with a large hall for 1000 seats, was made by Tomsk architect P. p. Naranovich. Korolev spent 150,000 rubles on the theater.
- Today I would like to tell you about several operating theatres in Tomsk.
- 1) Theatre 2+KU
- 2) Tomsk Drama Theatre



Theater survivors dolls "2+KU"-this place, where are created, live and work the Muppets on wrist. This is a special design of dolls, developed by Vladimir Zakharov. Today's dolls have full mechanics of revival: eyes, a mouth, fingers on hands move.

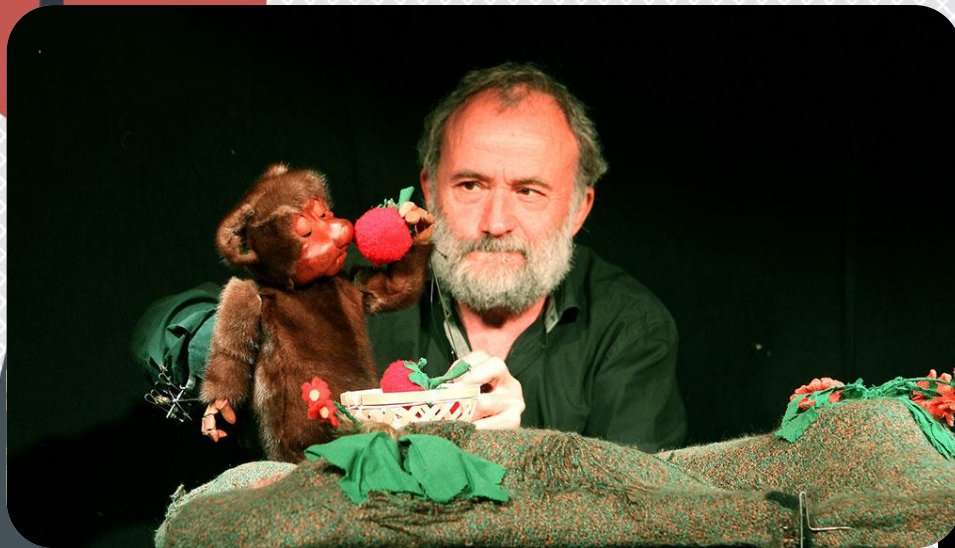


In 1991, Vladimir Zakharov and his wife founded the author's theater "2 + Ku", where Vladimir became a master puppeteer, a stagehand, a stage Director, and a screenwriter-philosopher. Almost immediately, dolls and mini-theater become an important attraction of Tomsk.

In total, Vladimir Zakharov created and played more than 15 performances based on his own plays and texts by other authors. In December 2018, the theatre "2+Ku" premiered a new play - "the Story of another doll", a ballet without words, created especially for children.



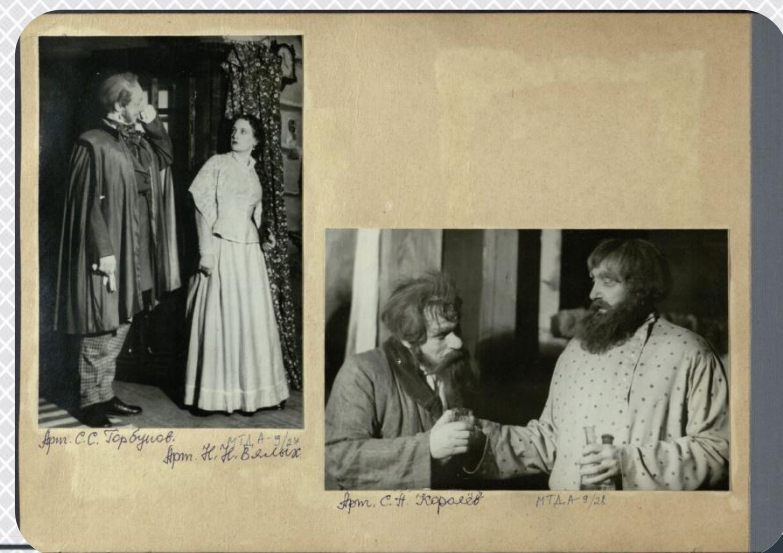
Late in the evening on February 1, 2019 a number of mass media of the city of Tomsk reported about a strong fire "near theater" 2+Ku.Vladimir Zakharov, who tried with a bucket of water to extinguish the fire inside the Studio at the theater, entered the smoke-filled room, but did not come out. Vladimir Zakharov died at the age of 65.



Drama THEATER. The great city theatre was organized in November 1922 in the former Public Assembly building. In 1923 it was transformed into a drama and Comedy Theatre named after A. V. Lunacharsky. In August 1941, the Tomsk theatre was transferred to Kemerovo. From 1941 to 1944 the first Belarusian state theatre w



The recreated regional theater opened in Tomsk on April 30, 1945, bringing together the troupe of the front-line theater named after V. P. Chkalov, artists who returned from Kemerovo and Narym. Thus, the Tomsk theater received the name of V. P. Chkalov, which was on its posters until 1992. Initially, the theater was located at Nakhanovich lane, 4, now here is the Tomsk young spectator theater; in these rooms, the regional drama theater worked until 1978.



The modern building of the theater is located on the site where the food market and shopping malls were located, on Lenin square, 4. The management of the theater and the Department of culture of the regional administration plan to reconstruct the building. The theater has two stages: the main and small.
