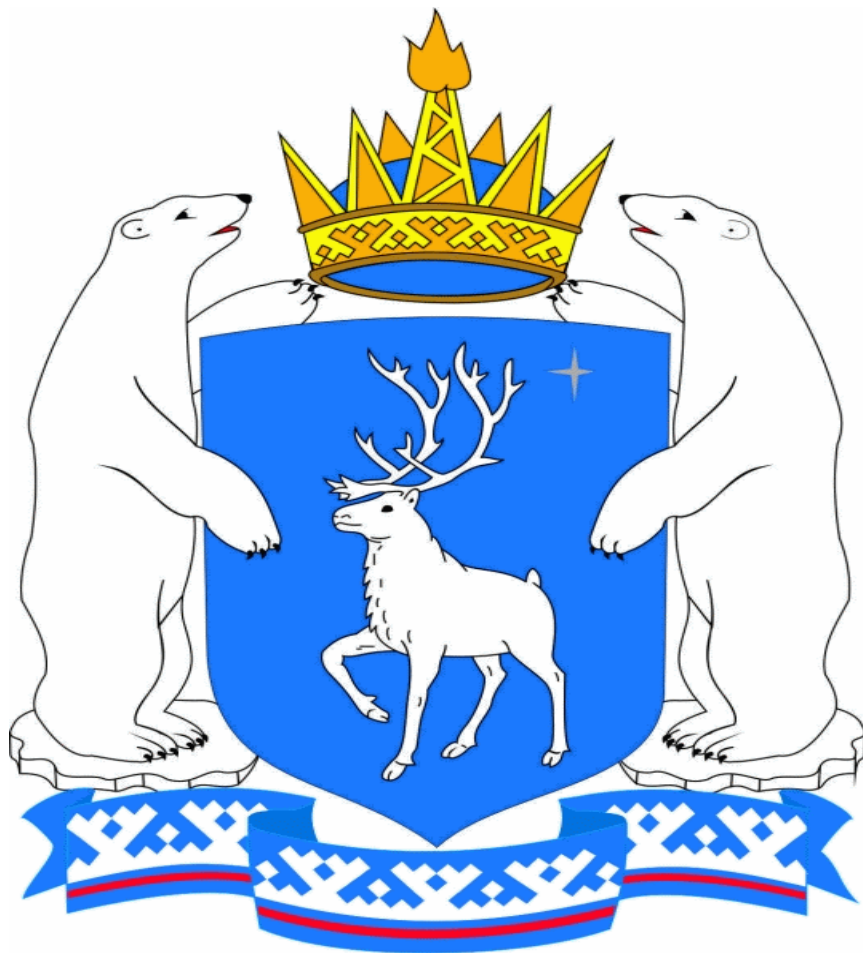

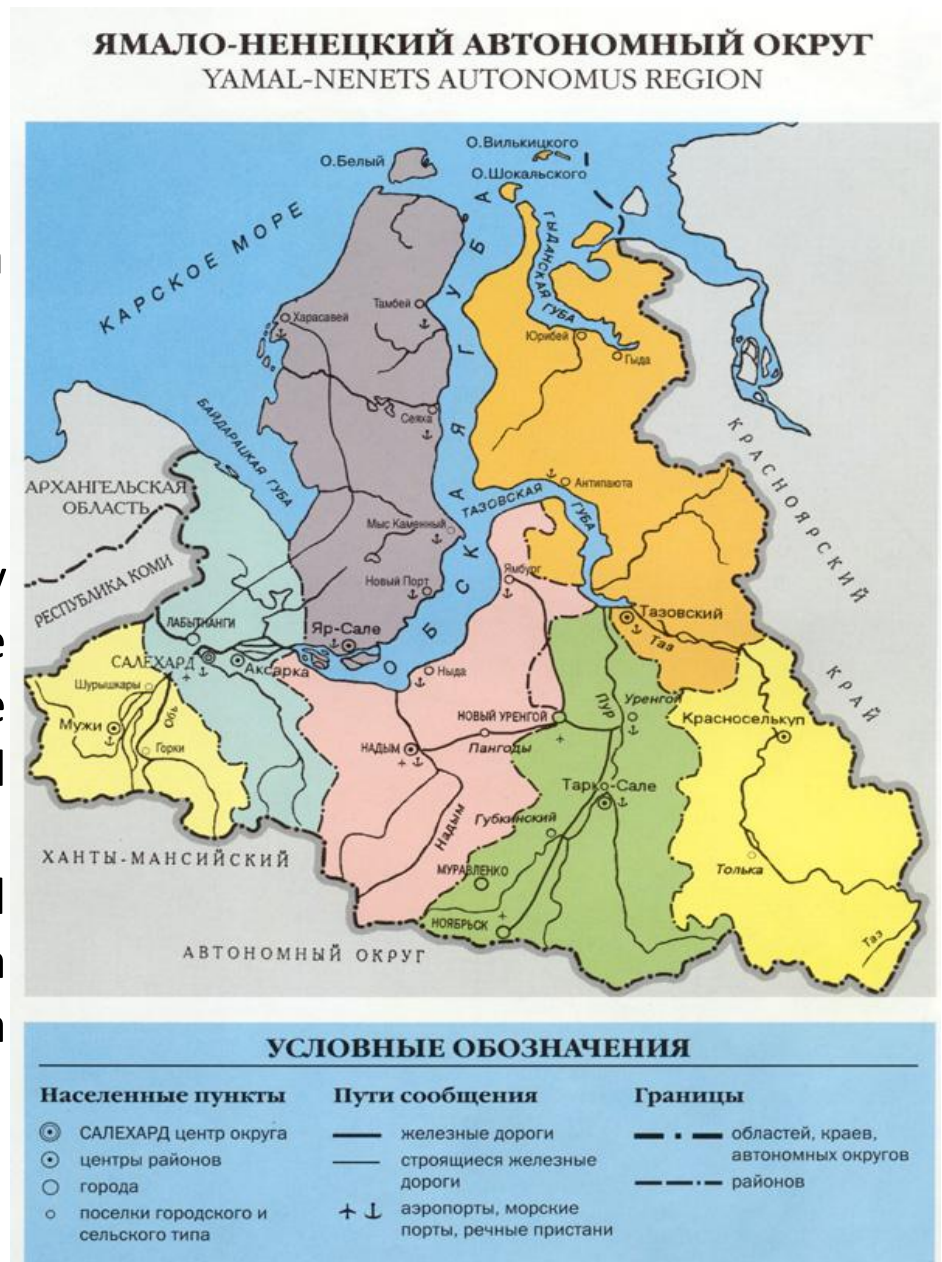
Flag



The region is located in the Arctic zone of the West Siberian Plain, belongs to the regions of the Far North. It covers a large area which is one and a half times larger than the territory of France (547 030 км²) or Spain (504 782 км²).

The climate is determined by the presence of permafrost, the proximity of the cold Kara Sea, the abundance of bays, rivers, swamps and lakes.

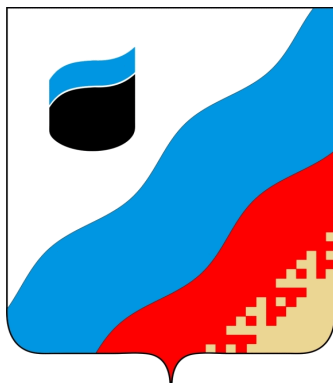
In general, the region is characterized by a long winter (up to 8 months), a short summer, strong winds, and a small amount of snow cover.

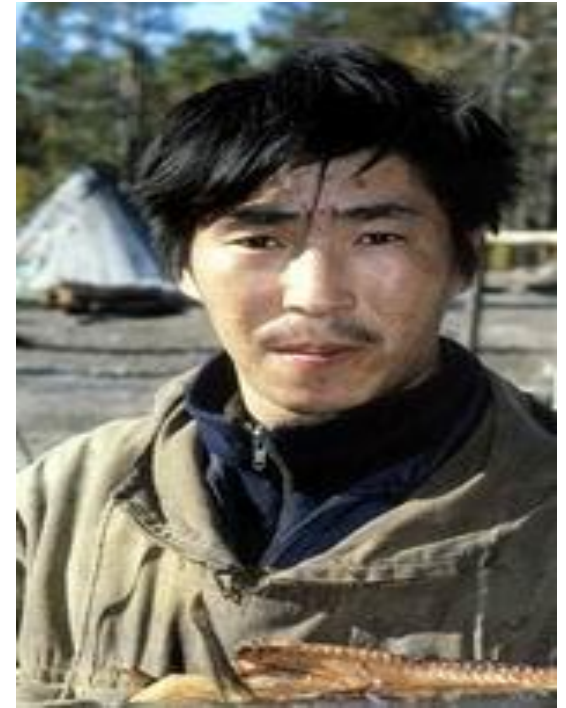
The core of the indigenous aboriginal population of Yamal is the Nenets. Population is about **34 190 people**.

Despite the nearby cities with the benefits of 21st century civilization, many tribes continue to live like their ancestors a hundred or two hundred years ago: they lead a nomadic lifestyle, hunting, fishing and herding reindeer.





At present, the Khanty are settled within the Khanty-Mansiysk and Yamalo-Nenets Autonomous region, as well as in the northern regions of the Tomsk Region. Population is about 22 283 people.



The official name of the people - Selkups - comes from the self-name of the northern ethnographic group and is translated as a forest man. Population is about 1700 people.

The Reindeer Herder's Day is a traditional, annual national holiday of the indigenous people of Yamal. It is celebrated in spring .
