➤ Настоящее завершённое время

- Это время употребляется, если известен **результат действия**. Образуется: have (has) + глагол в 3-й форме (неправильные); правильные глаголы + ed.
- E.g. He **has visited** his friends.
- They **have written** the letter.
- Слова-показатели этого времени: never, ever, always, lately, recently, for ages, often, just, since, this...
