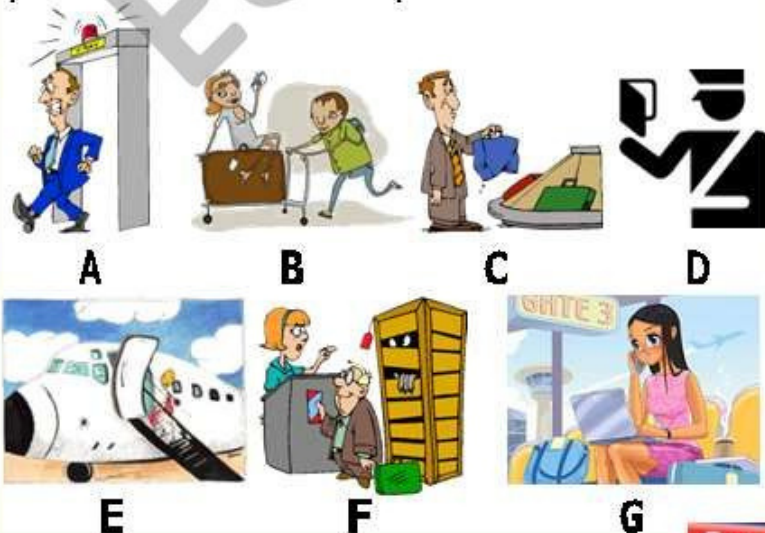

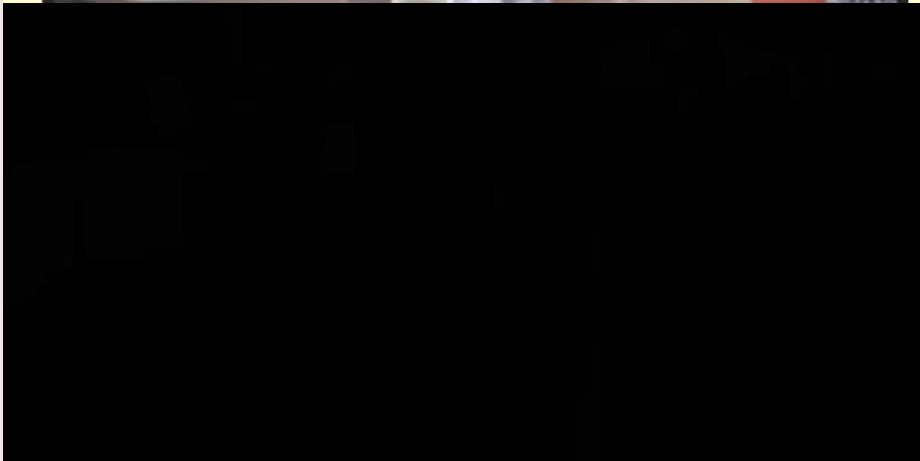

Prague, Czech Republic

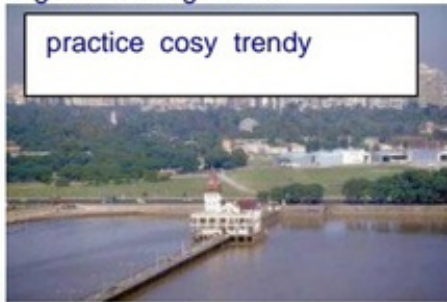

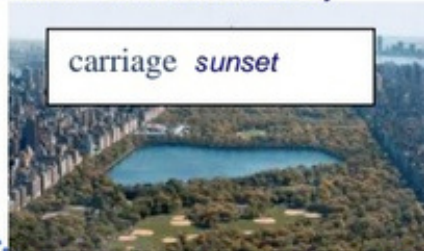

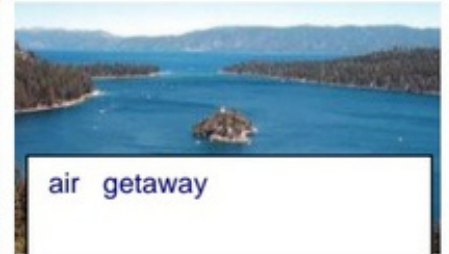
